Mid-America is one of the largest charter clubs of the American Saddlebred Horse Association with close to 400 members who own and compete with Saddlebreds, Road Horses and Hackney Ponies.

The organization produces three shows a year and oversees a regional circuit of 25 affiliated A and B rated shows (in Illinois and surrounding states) where members earn points toward year-end awards.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

HORSE SHOW OFFICE HOURS: The horse show office will close one hour before each performance. Entries for classes within a performance should be made prior to that closing. Check posted hours for additional closings.

\$35 CHARGE FOR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES: Entries not containing all necessary documents to verify eligibility for horse/rider/owner/trainer/handler will be considered incomplete. Copies of registration papers showing proof of current ownership or lease, copies of current ASHBA and ADHHA membership cards must accompany entry blanks, which must include the REQUIRED three signatures and complete addresses for owners and trainers.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS: Mid-America Horse Show Association requires that all Exhibitors, Trainers and Owners participating at Mane Event be registered members of the Association. Non-members are permitted to join at a pro-rated fee as indicated on the Entry Form.

OPEN CHECK: To facilitate office procedures, all exhibitors/trainers will be required to leave a blank signed check in the show office before numbers will be released.

CREDIT POLICY: If there is a history of returned checks or declined credit cards with an exhibitor, they are required to remit payment in the form of cash, cashier's check or certified check to MAHSA for any current and future show fees. If using a credit card they must pay the open balance prior to the start of the show. Otherwise cash only will be accepted at the end of the show to close out account.

CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS: All credit card charges are subject to a 4% processing fee.

REFUNDS: Exhibitors cancelling entries after closing date without a vet certificate shall forfeit their entry fees. NO REFUND OF STALL RENT, OFFICE OR ESC FEES. No refunds will be made during the show.

FAILURE TO ENTER/SCRATCH: A \$25 fine will be charged to any exhibitor who fails to enter or fails to scratch an entry at least one hour prior to the start of the performance in which the entry would compete.

ALL STABLING IN ENCLOSED BARN: Stalls will be available on Monday, October 14, 2024 by 12:00 noon. Unless a horse is entered, it may not occupy a stall until all competition horses are accommodated.

ALL HORSES: HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: All horses on the show grounds must be in good health. Animals showing evidence of contagious or infectious diseases will be removed from the grounds by order of the official veterinarian. Horses originating from outside Illinois must be accompanied by an Interstate Health Certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian within thirty (30) days prior to exhibition identifying each horse and certifying that it is free, insofar as can be determined from infectious disease. A negative Coggins test for Equine Infectious Anemia within twelve (12) months and proof of Rhinopneumonitis (Rhino/flu) vaccination within six (6) months of entering the stables or the fairgrounds must accompany each horse. These documents must be recorded by the office personnel for each horse brought onto the fairgrounds. An official veterinarian will be designated to make official inspections and rulings in all cases where the opinion of

a veterinarian is required. No one shall approach a veterinarian with regard to his or her decision unless he or she first obtains permission from the Show Committee who shall arrange an appointment with the veterinarian at a proper time and place.

UPHA CLASSICS: Open to any horse nominated and kept eligible with UPHA. Money will be added to entry fees collected and dispersed to winners in each Classic.

JUNIOR HORSE JACKPOT CLASSES IN FIVE-GAITED, THREE-GAITED, FINE HARNESS, PARK AND PARK PLEASURE: Purse money will include all class sponsorships and entry fees. 100% of the purse will be split – 50% to the owners and 50% to the trainers of all ribbon winners up to 8 places. (See page 4 for details.)

SUNRISE JUNIOR HORSE HUNTER CHALLENGE: Sunrise Junior Horse Hunter Challenge is open to American Saddlebred horses 4 years and under and shown by an Amateur or Professional. The entry fee is \$50 which will be added back in to the class payout of \$350. Payouts will be 40%, 20%, 15%, 10%, 5% for each class. If less than 6 horses are in the class, money not paid out will be divided evenly amongst ribbon winners.

Class Specs and Procedure: Open to four-year-olds and under. May be shown by a professional or amateur. To be shown at a walk, trot, extended trot, canter and extended canter both ways of the ring. Entries must be asked both ways of the ring to halt and stand quietly on the rail. To be judged on suitability as a Hunter, manners, performance, conformation, and quality. In the line, horses must stand quietly with all four legs perpendicular to the ground. Horse shall be required to back readily in the line.

MID-AMERICA ROADSTER CHALLENGE: Purse money will include \$90,000 added money and \$400 from each entry fee collected. \$2,000 Incentive for Winning Trainer. \$1,000 Incentive for Reserve Trainer. (See page 9 for details.)

THREE-YEAR-OLD STANDARDBRED BREEDER'S CUP: Purse money will include \$35,000 added money and requires a \$1,000 nomination fee. (See insert for details.)

\$500 "JACKPOT" FIVE GAITED, THREE GAITED, FINE HARNESS AND PARK STAKES: Open to all; no qualification required. Purse money to be split 50/50 between owners and trainers of top five horses. Purse Distribution: \$150/\$125/\$100/\$75/\$50.

STAKE/CHAMPIONSHIP ELIGIBILITY: Horse or pony must be entered, shown and judged in a class in the same section. To qualify for an Amateur, Ladies, Adult or Junior Exhibitor Stake/Championship, horse/pony must have been shown in a class in the same section by an amateur, lady or junior exhibitor.

The management of the Horse Show reserves the right to cancel any class(es) when there are less than four (4) entries and to combine or divide any class or classes should such be in the best interest of the show. All exhibitors will be notified of such changes before the first performance of each session.

ALL DOGS MUST BE LEASHED

Competition and Warm-up footing is sawdust and dirt on clay.

Competition arena: Coliseum of Champions, 116' x 241'.

Warm-up: Covered Arena 121' x 204', Barn 13 181' x 111', Barn 14 150' x 100'.

HOLD HARMLESS STATEMENT: The Mid-America Horse Show Association Mane Event Show is governed by the Equine Sports Council. The Equine Sports Council provides rules and standards, marketing, support and education to their network of horse shows with an emphasis on integrity, sportsmanship and safety. For more information visit EquineSportsCouncil.org. The ESC General Rules can be found on the ESC website, and midamericahorseshow.com. A hard copy of the Equine Sports Council Rules will also be available in the show office.

The Mid-America Horse Show Association Mane Event Horse Show is an ASHBA Star Rated Show and Saddlebred classes will run under USEF Saddlebred breed rules per the ASHBA Star Show agreement.

Mid-America Horse Show Association will not be responsible for any loss or damage or injury to horses exhibited, or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost or destroyed, or in any way damaged. Each exhibitor will be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person, whomsoever, by any horse owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify the Mid-America Horse Show Association, or any member thereof, against all claims and demands, of any kind or nature, that may grow out of any injury occasioned by any horse owned or exhibited by them, or arise from the negligence of the person in charge of any such horse. All horses exhibited at this show will be entirely at the owner's risk.

GOLF CART RENTALS: Golf carts are available for rent from the Illinois Department of Agriculture, but must be reserved in advance. Personal golf carts require a fairgrounds permit. To rent a cart or get a permit for a personal cart, contact Non-Fair Events Office at 217/782-1698.

MINOR MUST HAVE DRIVER'S LICENSE: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties.

Qualifications for the Mid-America Roadster Challenge Class

1. The Mid-America Roadster Challenge Class #46 is open to horses purchased at the 2022 or 2023 Fall Mid-America Trotting Sale.
2. All consigned horses eligible for the Mid-America Roadster Challenge Class cannot have been shown prior to the date of the Sale.
3. All consigned horses must change ownership at the time of the Sale or they will not be eligible for the Mid-America Roadster Challenge Class.
4. Winners of the Mid-America Roadster Challenge will not be eligible for future competition in this class.
5. \$100.00 must be received with the Entry Blank by the closing date set by the show. The remaining \$400.00 must be paid in the Horse Show Office 24 hours in advance of the Class. Post entries are allowed with a \$500.00 per late entry.
6. Entries must qualify by showing in a minimum of 4 classes at 2 horse shows.
7. Entries must be registered with the American Road Horse & Pony Association.
8. Owners/Trainers/Drivers must be members of the American Road Horse & Pony Association.
9. Drivers must be 18 years of age or older.
10. NOTE: In the event there are more than 10 entries in the class, there will be an elimination round. As per ESC rules, there cannot be more than 10 entries.

\$400.00 of the \$500.00 Entry Fee will be added to the Purse.

The Preliminary class(es) shall also serve as an elimination for the Championship and both consist of two phases – Phase 1 is rail work; Phase 2 is the mandatory workout (figure 8 at the canter, trot back to the judges, stop and back in Preliminary Section) and a workout of judges' selection in Championship Section.

From the Preliminary, judges shall select 10-15 riders to compete in the Championship. Further testing of any rider may be requested at the judges' discretion. Judging is based 40% on rail work and 60% on workout.
