Mid-America Spring Fling Check List

Eliminate incomplete entry fees. Utilize this check list as your guideline.

Welcome to the 2023 show season! The check list below will help facilitate your entries. Back numbers will not be issued until all information is complete.

All horses entering the facility (whether exhibiting or not) must have proof of Rhinopneumonitis (Rhino/flu) vaccination within 6 months.

BEFORE YOU MAIL THE ENTRIES PLEASE REVIEW REQUIREMENTS BELOW:

- _____ Proof of current owner registration (horse/pony)
- _____ Proof of Negative Coggins
- _____ Proof of Rhinopneumonitis within 6 months (every horse/pony)
GR845 Equine Vaccination Rule:
Horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.
- _____ Three signatures on reverse side of entry blank. If doing entries on line the release form must be signed and accompany the entries.
- _____ Proof of AHHS (Hackney) current (2023) membership for every owner and trainer
- _____ Proof of ASHBA current (2023) competing membership for every owner, trainer and exhibitor (Opportunity and Walk/Trot classes exempt) for ASHBA high points and to qualify for the 2023 Kentucky State Fair Horse Show.
- _____ Proof of UPHA current (2023) membership (and horse enrollment where applicable) for all UPHA classes.
- _____ Every owner, trainer, exhibitor must be a current member of Mid-America Horse Show Association
- _____ Current address for owner, trainer and exhibitor
- _____ Email address for trainer, owner and exhibitor (very important as this is how we can communicate changes and news releases to you regarding the show)
